



Overview winners Janneke Fruin-Helb grant

Since 2003, LUF has awarded a €1,000 annual prize to the student who submits the best grant application to LUF International Study Fund (LISF) for research abroad with an exceptionally good and creative research question formulated with academic freedom in mind. This so-called Janneke Fruin-Helb grant was established in 2003 on the occasion of the retirement of Ms A.M. Fruin-Helb, who was director of the Leiden University Fund from 1989 to 2003 and co-founder of the LUF International Study Fund.
